


Tree Song - Family Art Activity

This project creates a physical Family Tree that will last for ages and ages to come, connecting past, present and future.

Directions:

1. Find out your family history. What country do you come from? What cities have/has your family lived in? What names has your family had? Great idea to have kids ask grandparents information!
2. Color paper with pencils or paint. Cut out leaves for each member of your family.
3. Cut out limbs for tree from brown colored paper for each family.
4. Write names of people on leaves, family name on limbs.
5. Glue leaves to limbs and limbs to the tree.
