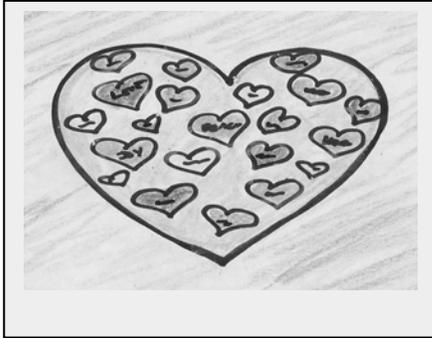


A Love Song - Family Art Activity

Word Art Heart Collage

This project gives a daily visual reminder to use positive, healthy, kind words instead!

Directions:

1. Ask the kids to name some kind, positive words.
2. Write on pieces of paper those words.
3. Draw hearts around the words. Color hearts.
4. Cut out.
5. Glue onto a giant heart or square if you wish piece of paper.
6. Post on fridge or a place family sees everyday to remind us to be kind!
